Our key mission statement for junior golf at BPGC is fun and safety, we intend to encourage juniors to enjoy the game whilst we will endeavour to work towards good practices for safety and support of the child.

Key membership benefits include:

- Free, specialised junior coaching – group and individual lessons available.
- A fabulous, mature 27 hole golf course – no restrictions for Juniors.
- Start times for competitions only, otherwise just turn up and play.
 - Juniors only room with pool table and TV.
- Members may sign in up to 3 guests per day at discounted rates.
 - Discount off all food & drink purchases in the Clubhouse.
 - Unlimited use of short & long game practise areas.
- Plentiful & diverse range of competitions & team matches.

Junior Membership

Junior Membership – Cost & Conditions

The Junior subscription for 2016/17 is set at £15 per annum for 14's and under and £50 for 15-18 year olds with no joining fee required. Belton Park adopts a “no barrier” route to membership in that there is no requirement for a proposer and absolutely no interviews!

A Junior member must be under 18 years old at the start of the membership year.

A Junior member will not be asked to pay a joining fee when graduating into adult membership, providing membership does not lapse.

Junior Membership – Code of Conduct

1. On arrival at the golf club it would be preferable for the junior player(s) under the age of 16 to first report into the Professionals shop before play or practice.
2. Upon leaving the club the junior golfer should inform the shop only after the correct person has arrived to pick them up.
3. Parents will be encouraged to only pick up from clubhouse or putting green and as much as possible avoid a child waiting at the car park.
4. We feel it would be best practice for all juniors to carry their mobile phone in their bag on the silent setting only.
5. No junior under the age of 12 can play on their own.
6. All juniors are asked to abide by the games rules of etiquette and standards of behaviour.
7. Juniors are asked to not dwell in the locker room.
8. No alcoholic drink will be bought for a junior under 18.
9. Whilst Juniors under 16 are exempt from the dress rule, they should be smartly dressed at all times.
10. Juniors should be respectful to other members, both junior and adult.
11. Juniors must be respectful of the rules and etiquette of the game of golf. They will be provided with guidelines to this end.
12. Juniors are expected to be respectful of the Club, course and buildings.
13. Juniors are asked to adhere to instructions as given by any BPGC staff.

Junior Membership – Duty of Care

Belton Park Golf Club is committed to providing a safe environment for Juniors to participate in the game of golf. We do this by:

- Recognising that all children and young people have the right to respect and freedom from abuse.
 - Ensuring that all the BPGC volunteers and staff are carefully selected.
 - Responding swiftly to allegations of abuse of children and young people in our care.
 - Appointing a Child Protection Officer.
 - Ensuring access to confidential information is restricted.
 - Ensuring all volunteers are given Child Protection awareness training.
1. B.P.G.C. subscribes to, and works within, the guidelines and recommendations of “Children In Golf” (CIG). For more details, visit www.childreningolf.org or obtain details from the Club office.
 2. B.P.G.C. has adopted the CIG Child Protection Policy.
 3. B.P.G.C. will use photography to promote and celebrate golf, and also as a teaching aid. All photography will be used sensitively and within the CIG guidelines.
 4. At times through the year the club play matches at other venues. To do this at present we are reliant on the generosity of adult members for their time in taking the teams. Our policy regarding the above is:
 - All cars used will have their relevant details logged.
 - All drivers will have filled out a self -disclosure form.
 - In all available circumstances one adult will stay on site with the juniors while the match is played.
 5. B.P.G.C. will, with your authority, provide First Aid or seek emergency treatment should your child suffer an injury or become ill whilst playing golf. B.P.G.C. will always attempt to contact you prior to taking any action.
