

2021 Revised Programme of Events

April 8th ADA Trophy (1991)

This will be a 9-hole medal competition played on the Brownlow Deer Course (holes 1-9) for golf access juniors (blue tees). The winner will receive the ADA trophy which will be called the Access Development Award. Tee off times from 2.00 pm.

April 8th Ancaster Shield (1983)

This will be a 9-hole medal competition also played on the Brownlow Deer Course (holes 1-9) open to all juniors with a handicap to be played from the red tees on holes 19-27. Tee off times from 2.30 pm.

TBA Jeremy Grace Trophy (1984)

This will be an 18-hole Stableford event for boys and girls on the Belmont Course (holes 10-27) with a maximum handicap of 54. Tees will be yellow for boys and reds for girls.

Tee off times from 2.00 pm.

August 2nd Stanrene Cup (1965)

This will be an 18-hole medal competition for boys and girls on the Ancaster Course (holes 19-27) with a maximum handicap allowance of 36. Boys will play from yellow tees and girls will play from the reds. Juniors with a higher handicap than 36 will be allowed to play but would need to play off 36 for this competition. Tee off times from 1.00 pm.

TBA Ian Ward Trophy (2006)

This will be an 18-hole Stableford event for boys and girls played on the Belmont Course (holes 10-27) with a maximum handicap of 54. Tees will be yellow for boys and red for girls. Tee off times from 1.00 pm.

3rd August Junior League Match at Greetham Valley

August 26th Junior Club Championship (1993)

This competition will remain as the premier event for our Juniors but will be split into two separate events. The existing trophy will be played for by boys and girls with a maximum handicap of 36 over 18 holes on the Brownlow Course (holes 1-18). Boys will play a medal competition from the white tees and girls from the reds.

For all golfers with a higher handicap than 36 there will be a new trophy to be played for over 9 holes on the Deer course (blue tees). This will also be a medal format.

Summer Fun Competitions

We will be holding a number of regular fun team events over the summer evenings from May through to September. They will vary in format and will include Am Am events, Texas Scrambles, Greensomes and other fun team games. We hope to make these family evenings and all will be 9 hole events and some will have food afterwards. The number of events that we put on will very much depend on the numbers that enter but we hope that these will be very popular and relaxed evenings but with a competitive edge.

Other Competitions

Junior Open (1990) County Event. 6th August. This is an open competition linked to the Lincolnshire Union of Golf Clubs competition-the Woodroffe Walter Cup and is held at Belton Park Golf Club. The format is 36 hole medal with boys playing from the white tees and girls from the reds. The Plamore trophy is presented to the best nett player. In the morning the Daily Telegraph competition is played for. We hope that some of our Juniors will be able to represent Belton Park in this prestigious event.

Little Imps. Having been cancelled completely in 2020 we now have confirmation that all Little Imps events from July onwards will take place. It will now be a series of five 9 hole events played at five different clubs designed for youngsters who are just entering the world of golf between the ages of 6 and 14.
