### Category of membership

- A Student member is aged 19 to 21 years of age at the start of the membership year and in full time education.
- An Intermediate member is aged 19 to 21 years of age at the start of the membership year but not in full time education.
- There are three thresholds of Cadet member as highlighted above. Cadets will become 'full' members at the subscription renewal following their 30<sup>th</sup> birthday.
- Country "1" is one whose main residence is over 75 miles, as the crow flies, from the club.
- Country "2" is one whose main residence is between 25 & 75 miles, as the crow flies, from the club.
- Armed Forces Members – full membership rights at current rates but with the ability to suspend membership at any time, for a minimum period of one month, when being deployed elsewhere. Details of deployment to be confirmed, in writing, by the members' superior officer.
- An overseas member is one who resides outside of the UK for in excess of 6 months per year.
- Community Membership – Belton Park Golf Club supports Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASC). The Club is open to the whole community without discrimination including those on low or modest incomes. Anyone able to demonstrate that normal membership fees are beyond their means will be entitled to join the Club and participate at a cost of £480 a year – T & C's apply. ### Subscriptions

The subscription year commences on 1<sup>st</sup> May. When joining through the year, the fees due will be charged on a pro rata basis.

### Monthly Payment

The monthly payment plan enables a member to spread the payment over the subscription year via a direct debit facility. Members who choose to pay by this method shall commit to being a member for the duration of the membership year, 1<sup>st</sup> May to 30<sup>th</sup> April, and shall settle all instalments in full for the duration of the agreement. The quoted figures include the subscription plus a small surcharge.
